4. Handling and Storage

Handling	The product can be worked with conventional machines and tools. Before machining the product should have room temperature and/or to be stored for min. 24h under normal climatic conditions. Chips must be removed during machining to prevent the risk of slipping. Local workplace-related dust limit values must be considered. Suitable extraction or ventilation on the processing machines must be ensured. Safety goggles must be worn during machining. General dust limit value: Respirable dust (6 mg/m³); Inhalable dust (10 mg/m³).
Storage	The semi-finished products should be protected from external damage. Direct sunlight, UV rays, ionizing radiation, chemical contact, etc. should be avoided.
Safety measures	The general industrial safety recommendations should be considered. Thermal damage should be avoided during machining.
